

FRENCH BULLDOG HEALTH SCHEME

Dogs that show any sign of suffering from BOAS and dogs that have received treatment for BOAS and can now breathe should not be bred from.



Did you know that your Frenchie is just a few steps away from achieving their GOLD certificate? For your Frenchie to progress to the Gold level you will need to comply with the criteria below.

- Your French Bulldog **MUST** be over 2 years of age and hold both Bronze and Silver certificates. KC Registration No and Microchip No must be shown on all results along with the KC registered name, colour, sex and DOB
- 2. To have obtained a BOAS grade of 0 or 1 with the official Kennel Club and University of Cambridge Respiratory Function Grading Scheme. This test must be performed by a approved assessor.**
- A heart) examination (auscultation only (Normal result)
- Spine Xrays . Dorso-ventral and lateral view required which must be evaluated and scored by your vet. Download the form from the website
- You MUST include a stamped self addressed envelope (C5 size**
- PLUS 4 unused 2nd class stamps) to receive your certificate . The stamps go towards the admin cost of the scheme.**

- Coat Colour DNA proof that the dog only carries UK KENNEL CLUB STANDARD COAT COLOURS

NB You will not receive your certificate without a SAE and 4 unused stamps.
