As I hadn't judged the breed in this country for a few years, having only judged abroad lately, I was very intrigued to see how the breed had fared since I last judged them. I was very pleased to see so many quality young dogs. Having judged French bulldogs for many years, I find the breed still in the hands of good enthusiasts and sensible breeders in the main. I found the same sort of faults that I found twenty years ago and I'm sure if I'm lucky enough to judge them in twenty years time will see the same, some of the newer people coming into the breed have filled the gaps by those we have lost, hopefully to become the well known and respected kennel names of the future. I found enough well bred, healthy examples amongst this entry and I very much enjoyed judging them, thank you to everyone that bought their dogs under me.

## Minor Puppy Dog :

1<sup>st</sup> : Humpries and Lowton's - Lumillion Roc N'roe

Nice looking brindle with shapely body, good shoulders and front, nice roach finishing to sufficient amount of tail. Good rear angulation. Nicely developing head, with a good width of muzzle for age, framed with nice ears all carried on a good well shaped neck. Good movement for one so young.

2<sup>nd</sup> Gura-Mallon's – Allankee Rock n' Roll Celticlibrid

Another nice brindle, with very pleasing head, dark well set eyes, good muzzle, with nice layback, lips and underjaw, correct ears used well, good front and nice feet. Although he is developing nicely, on the day he lost out to 1 on maturity of body.

3<sup>rd</sup> English's – Barmark The Prince Consort

## Puppy Dog :

1<sup>st</sup> : Hogan's - Xentique Pandamonium for Baclaudi

Such a sumptuous lovely pied boy, a real eyecatcher, developing nicely within his frame, good bone and muscle tone without being overdone. Head young but still masculine, with confident expression, dark eyes well set and of good shape. very nice muzzle, layback and underjaw. Pleasing body shape front and rear, with good cut up and roach. Very sound movement from all angles. A pleasure to award him Best Puppy against a very nice bitch puppy. He also gave his peers a very close challenge in the line up.

2<sup>nd</sup> : Smith and Pratt's – Khanin Dexy's Midnite Runner

Nice dark masked fawn with good muzzle and well developed cheeks. Plenty of bone and nice feet. good movement.

3<sup>rd</sup> : Epps and Friday's – Ossidcla Show Boat

## Junior Dog :

1<sup>st</sup> : Brown's – Forbes De Elka Gyvybes Zyme at Kuredeux

Smart stylish brindle of good size. Has a very nice expression and good pigmentation, good ears carried well and of right shape and size. Nice aspect to his muzzle and nice curve of his under jaw. Straight front with feet tight, well shaped with good nails. He is still a young dog and his head needs to broaden slightly and his body needs to develop a little more overall muscle to fulfil his obvious potential. Showed and moved very well

2<sup>nd</sup> : Drummond's – Renuar Financial Times Glenlee

Very appealing mature dark masked fawn, with nice overall head, square with nice shape ears carried well, nice compact body of good shape and size. Sturdy straight front on good feet. nice rear angulation. Alas he would not settle for his handler to show at his best, but his quality was apparent to place him in the upper level of this class.

3<sup>rd</sup> : Seward and Bracher's – Jarmanyhill Cullinan

### Graduate Dog :

1<sup>st</sup> : Brown's – Forbes De Elka Gyvybes Zyme at Kuredeux

(1<sup>st</sup> previous class)

2<sup>nd</sup>: Seffer's – Crashkon The One Catrelma

Nice fawn with large ears, well boned and good covering of muscle. Sufficient angulation front and rear, moved freely around the ring. Very nice fawn colour coat of good texture. I would have liked a slightly darker mask

3<sup>rd</sup>: Pleasance's – Hard Rock Anima Mea at Katakia JW

### Post Graduate Dog :

1<sup>st</sup> : Guar-Mallon's – Celticlibrid Hammer to Fall

Nice brindle dog, ideal size for his age, still needs to mature a bit to give full finish. Pleasing face with dark eyes, well defined stop and dark nose. Ideal depth of chest, straight front and nice feet, correct angulations front and rear with gentle roach. moved well.

2<sup>nd</sup> : Seward and Bracher's – Jarmanyhill Cullinan

Good brindle for size and shape, smooth flowing lines, nicely shaped chest, gentle roach and strong well shaped neck. well cut up to loin. Another young dog that needs to mature a bit more, 1<sup>st</sup> being just that fraction more mature in head.

3<sup>rd</sup> : Dunning's – Rozeldogue Who Da Man

### Limit Dog :

1<sup>st</sup> : Eskrett's – Risethor Sweeney Todd Sh.CM

Attractive brindle male with soft expression, square head, good cheeks and fill under eyes. Well defined flews and muzzle, nicely turned up underjaw. Correct ears in size and proportion to his head, carried well. Very nice coat with attractive brindling. Just the right amount of bone, straight front and well angled shoulders, ideal amount of muscle, gentle roach, well set tail. Moved well

2<sup>nd</sup> : Conway and Chapman's – Norcairn Fabulous Frank Sh CM

Fawn pied dog of solid stature, very good muscle tone, especially upper front legs, shoulders and rear. Nice depth of chest, straight front, strong pasterns and good feet. Pleasing head of good proportion on strong neck. Very well cut up to loin. I would have liked a slightly softer topline for overall appearance.

3<sup>rd</sup>: Smith and Pratt's – Jafrak Persuade Me at Khanin

### Open Dog :

1<sup>st</sup> : Cund and Harrop's – Ch Chelmbull Moon Pilot

Smart brindle of ideal size and balance, strong compact body shape, wide straight front on sound feet and pasterns. gentle roach, finished into well set tail of ideal size. Chest of good depth and shape, well cut up to loin. Well covered shoulders and rear with good angulations. Masculine square head in balance with his body, framed with well placed ears carried upright and of good shape. Muzzle wide and deep. Well defined stop with ideal amount of roll over dark nose, sufficiently wrinkled forehead gentle domed of good width. Very well presented, moving very well at all times. A very worthy Dog CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> : Davis's – Breaksdale Teddy Edwards Rowendale

lovely fawn, masculine mature head of good shape, well developed cheeks, softly wrinkled forehead with good width between well used ears. Well arched neck and nice gently roached back to well set tail. Well developed muscular front, straight of good width, deep chest and strong pasterns, plenty of bone. Very well muscled rear, good angulation. moved very well from all angles. Just preferred the overall compactness of 1<sup>st</sup> . Awarded well deserved Reserve CC.

3<sup>rd</sup> : Gura-Mallon's – Celticlibrid Wilbur

### Minor Puppy Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Moseley's – Rubrics Deadly Nightshade

Extremely nice brindle puppy, so pretty, lovely body, great shape and balance. Sturdy, compact, lovely topline, well placed tail, well arched neck, straight front, just the right amount of angulation front and rear, good feet, well covered body for one so young. Rich dark eyes, feminine expression, lovely young head with such promising features. Moved well. I hope I have the chance to judge her again when she reaches full maturity

2<sup>nd</sup> : Evans and Jarret's – Rowendale Black Cherry

Another really nice brindle, with shapely body, ideal size for her age, square head with a very feminine face, well shaped ears of good size in balance to head, carried well. Just enough bone, straight front, good rear. Moved really well.

3<sup>rd</sup> : Massey's – Eastonite Polar Rose

### Puppy Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Seffer's - Catrelma Cottati Coutier

Feminine pied bitch, on sturdy legs and sound feet, straight front, good shoulders, gentle roach flowing into nicely angled rear, sufficient cut up to loin and nicely developing chest for age. Head promising but needs to mature, dark eyes of good shape and size well placed. Ears of good shape and size carried well. Nice shape of underjaw, muzzle of ideal width. Very sound movement, showing all the time.

2<sup>nd</sup> : Davis and Wildman's Rowendale Peanut Butter at Wildax

Quality fawn puppy with pretty face. Well developed head, padded cheeks, good fill under eyes, large well shaped ears, carried high. Strong straight front, with good depth of chest. Nice rear, with plenty of muscular development, because of the positive maturity of some parts of this puppy, other parts need to catch up for complete balance, which gave 1<sup>st</sup> the slight edge

3<sup>rd</sup> : James and Thompson's – Kalhols Best Deal With Bamabel

### Junior Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Bonsall's – Muggshotts Peep Show

Very attractive brindle bitch, full of character. Young but very nicely developed, well balanced with just the right amount of bone. Well muscled around upper front and shoulders, well developed strong loin and cut up, gentle roach. Strong rear with ideal bend of stifle. Very pretty head, square, good width and flat between nicely shaped ears, well padded, sufficient wrinkle of forehead when alert. Good mouth, curved underjaw, nice lip and padded flews. Overall a very nice picture, moved freely and confidently. Very pleased to award her Reserve CC

2<sup>nd</sup> : Fallows's – Crashkon Miss Diva

Nice size lighter brindle bitch. Well framed and balanced, everything just needs a little bit more maturity, but everything is there. Sweet expression and softly wrinkled forehead. Nice wide black nose and well defined stop. Ears carried and used to advantage. moved very well

3<sup>rd</sup> : Eskrett's – Risethor Paloma Picasso

### Graduate Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Wildman's – Wildax Princess Tippy Toes

Compact brindle, with attractive head and soft expression. nice size head, good cheeks and fill under her eyes, ideal dome of forehead with just the right amount of wrinkle. correct ears carried well. Nicely arched neck. Straight front of sufficient width, deep chest, nicely cut up to loin, gentle roach and well set tail. In very good coat, plenty of brindling. Very good movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> : Worrell's - Muggshotts Crazy Miss Daisy at Miamou

Very pretty pied bitch, double hooded, good width between ears, square head, eyes round of ideal size, well placed. Nice width of muzzle, with just enough lay back to nose. Well defined stop, ideal underjaw with good turn up. Excellent pigmentation. Straight front, strong, set upon compact feet. Good angulation front and rear. Ran a close second to class winner but was a little unsettled on the move

3<sup>rd</sup> : Longdon's Dalsa Sky Ryder Alsuma

#### Post Graduate Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Jones, Kendrick and Hughes's - Acirema Ana Matronic

Stylish black masked fawn bitch with appealing head and soft feminine expression and lovely dark eyes. Nicely domed forehead, symmetrical wrinkles when alert. All parts of muzzle good, width, depth and lay back, with curved underjaw and good mouth. Shapely body, good depth of chest, moved very well.

2<sup>nd</sup> : Holt and Banks's – Norcairn Dark N Dazzling at Bankholt

Brindle bitch with nice soft expression, good forehead, correct ear size and shape carried well. Strong arched neck.

Good cut up, gentle roach and nice rear. Showed very well.

3<sup>rd</sup> : Quin's – Bexbull Imperial Snowstorm at Nirojo

#### Limit Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Senior's – Kingrock Maple Syrup with Theapaul

Quality dark masked fawn, lovely size and shape very balanced. Beautiful feminine head, square, with softly wrinkled forehead. Lovely dark round eyes, well placed and with ideal width between. Nice wide muzzle with a lovely curved underjaw and good mouth. Ears of ideal size and shape, carried well making a pleasing frame. Strong arched neck without being excessive. Very good shoulders across nicely shaped chest with well sprung ribs. Good cut up to strong loin and gentle roach. Excellent strong rear of ideal width, good bend of stifle, with well developed pasterns front and rear, set on sound feet. Very good movement when viewed from all sides, showed extremely well. Pleased to award her the Bitch CC. Really stepped up in the challenge for Best of Breed against a very nice dog, it would have been tragedy not to award her it

2<sup>nd</sup> : Davis's – Rowendale Sherry Trifle

Nice mature fawn bitch, with a pleasant face and expression. Very nice ears, good forehead, well developed cheeks, good width of muzzle, nice lips and underjaw. Good body shape, gentle roach and strong rear, good movement. Very attractive coat colour.

3<sup>rd</sup> : Brooks and Cairns's – Barilballe Fifis Prima with Corursus Sh.CM

#### Open Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Bradford's – Siboveld's Santanna

Beautiful double hooded pied bitch with attractive brindle patches. Super feminine head, well developed cheeks, softly wrinkled forehead, nice shaped eyes, dark and well set. Dark wide nose, nicely laid back muzzle, wide well padded, with well turned up underjaw. Strong well arched neck. Nice strong shoulders, straight front, compact feet. Very good chest, deep with well sprung ribs. Moved really well.

2<sup>nd</sup> : Brown's – Sake De Elka Gyvybes Zyme at Kuredeux (Imp) JW ShCM

Smart brindle bitch, ideal size, compact body with just the right amount of bone. very pleasing head, dark eyes and soft feminine expression. Well defined stop and padded muzzle of good width, good mouth. Very good angulation of shoulders and rear. Good roach and well set tail of ideal size. Nice compact feet with short nails

3<sup>rd</sup> : Jones, Kendrick and Hughes's – Ch Tommyville Tully at Acirema

#### Veteran Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Souter's – Tommyville Topping at Greusaiche

Elegant lady full of life and character, feminine, nice overall size body with good angulation, moved very well

#### Good Citizen Bitch :

1<sup>st</sup> : Worrell's - Muggshotts Crazy Miss Daisy at Miamou (2<sup>nd</sup> Graduate Bitch)
