BP; 2 Seffer's Crashkon The One for Catrelma, fawn with good substance & bone, pleasing masculine head & well set ears, showed & moved well; 3 Drummond's Renuar Financial Times Glenlee. **JD** (7,3) 1 Pleasance's Hard Rockanima Mea at Katakia, pied with good substance & bone, pleasing masculine head & well set ears, showed & moved well; 2 Marshall's Siboveld's Quentin, brindle with good substance & bone, pleasing masculine head & well set ears, showed & moved well; 3 Thomas' King Arthur De Canipalma at Sandylake. **PGD** (9,3) Poulson's Patchdown Pilot, fawn with good substance & bone, pleasing masculine head & well set ears, showed & moved well. RDCC; 2 Smith & Pratt's Jafrak Persuade Me at Khanin, fawn of good type, lovely head with distinct expression, very good bat ears, Showed & moved well; 3 Marshall's Rozeldouge Top Notch. **LD** (5,2) 1 Mavro-Michaelis' Shoebridge Bergerac, fawn of medium size, large head with classical expression, dark round eyes, good undershot mouth, excellent neck & roach, moved well; 2 Poulson's Brandoux Valentinoux at Patchdown, fawn with good substance & bone, pleasing masculine head & well set ears, showed & moved well; 3 Pleasance's Eastonite Rocafella of Katakia. **OD** (8,2) 1 Cutter's Dapledan avec La Qualite, truly masculine brindle, powerful appearance. Large well balanced head with good stop & layback, strong straight front, excellent roach & hind assembly, excellent mover. CC; 2 Pearce's Kalhol's Pat Cash, fawn of medium size, large head with classical expression, dark round eyes, good undershot mouth, excellent neck & roach. Moved well; 3 Stewart's Pringham Mystro.

PB (10) 1 Pearce's Tillcarr Lipstick Floozie, truly brindle youngster, well balanced head with good stop & layback, good width & filling of under jaw, well arched neck, sufficiently short in loin, moved well; 2 Wakins-McGown's Frabull's Lets Get It On, brindle cubby baby, well shaped head with truly feminine expression, moved well & showed with confidence; 3 Hau's Essenceera Imogena. **JB** (12,1) 1 Mavro-Michaelis' Kontessa V H Bullenparadijs with Shoebridge, very feminine with large beautifully balanced head, dark eye, well set ears, straight front, moved well; 2 Morrison's Jafrak Ticket To Ryde, cubby fawn, well shaped head, dark eyes, good roach & angulations, showed & moved well; 3 Longdon's Dalspa Sky Ryder Alsuma. **PGB** (9,3) 1 Smith & Pratt's Jafrak Never Persuaded at Khanin, feminine brindle with beautifully balanced head, dark eye, well set ears, straight front, moved well; 2 Mavro-Michaelis' Shoebridge Cote D'auxerre, fawn pretty head with dark eyes, fine coat, showed well; 3 Scott's Amuelle Madame Monique. **LB** (7,2) 1 Esposito's Jafrak La Di Da Ossidcla, small brindle, with dark eyes, well set ears, nicely rounded ribcage, moved well; 2 Howarth's Gizyjo Gizy's Angel, fawn pretty head with dark eyes, fine coat, showed well; 3 Conway & Chapman's Norcairn Dark Encounter. **OB** (11,2) 1 Drummond's Renuar Roberta Bohemienne, brindle well shaped head, excellent ears, good width & filling of under jaw, well arched neck, sufficiently short in loin, good roach & angulations, moved well. CC & BOB; 2 Krall's Jafrak Doramaar, cobby fawn, well shaped head, dark eyes, good roach & angulations, showed & moved well; 3 Hines & Ashard's Rycolah Zephyr.

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
