

## **Vivien Watkins Bomlitz Classes 14/Oct/18 – French Bulldog Club of England**

### **Special Award Junior Dog or Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> – Louwrights Mon Chou At Kingfriend, *Mr D Friend*.

Brindle bitch with head square in appearance, flat skull, domed forehead, sufficient wrinkle, muzzle broad deep and set back, well defined stop, dark eyes, ears carried up right and parallel, correct mouth and dentition. Neck well arched and of moderate length, straight front, ribs well sprung, gentle roach and good cut up. Moderate rear angulation small and compact feet, small tail, with a free and flowing movement. Correct in size. Overall a lot to like about this young bitch.

2<sup>nd</sup> – Ascensions Winston Of Raglenary, *Ms M Coffey*.

Fawn male, 8 months old, nice shape head with flat skull between his ears, enough wrinkle, cheeks well developed, open nostrils, eyes dark, ears wide at base and rounded at top. Good length of neck, strong well boned body for juvenile, gentle roach, moderate angulation, good amount of tail, and sound on the move.

### **Special Award Open Dog**

1<sup>st</sup> – Eastonite Domino Dandy, *Mrs C Thomas*.

Brindle pied male with strong masculine head, flat skull and domed forehead, muscles of cheeks well developed with plenty of cushioning, well positioned dark eyes, ears carried up right and parallel, good mouth – under shot, but teeth not visible and tongue not protruding. Powerful well arched neck with a straight and muscular front, hind quarters muscular with moderate angulation. This boy moved with absolute soundness and was free and flowing. Loved his overall bone and substance.

2<sup>nd</sup> – Archness Sign O' The Times JW., *Ms V Bryant*.

Brindle male with a lovely strong looking masculine head which was square in appearance, flat skull, domed forehead, his muzzle was broad deep and set back with the muscles in the cheeks well developed. Lower jaw was deep and square, broad, slightly under shot and turned up. Dark eyes and well-set ears. Loved his head. His neck was of moderate length, gentle roach present, moderate rear angulation and moved well.

### **Special Award Open Bitch**

1<sup>st</sup> – Xentique B Witched for Taffique, *Mrs F Smith*

Brindle bitch, nice shape and size with a lovely expression. Flat skull, domed forehead, defined stop, plenty of cushioning with dark round eyes. Carried her ears well and upright, good length of neck, gentle roach and good cut up. Moderate rear angulation, good amount of tail and well set, correct coat. Moved well.

2<sup>nd</sup> – Priceless Princess, *Mrs N L Humphries*

Brindle bitch of correct size with a lovely expression. Super domed forehead with a flat skull. Her muzzle was set back with a well-defined stop. Dark round eyes, good dentition, ears wide at base rounded at top, moderate length of neck, gentle roach, moderate angulation, and moved well. The overall condition of this five-year-old bitch was excellent – what a super little lady.
